RENTAL AGREEMENT & KEY FOB INFORMATION

If you are renting a unit at Honolulu Park Place, our access control program automatically turns off your key fob's access on the last day of your rental agreement. Your key fob provides your access into the condominium, the parking garage, elevators, club, and other common areas at HPP.

Here is a friendly reminder of the Association's policy:

If you renew or extend your rental agreement (or go on a month-to-month basis), our administrative office requires a copy of your new rental agreement or lease so they can reprogram your key fob's new access date.

You can also have your rental agent or landlord email a letter to our office indicating your new rental term. Because the access control program is date specific, the rental agreement or letter must indicate the month, day, and year of the extension.
