#### An Energy-Efficient Future

When Honolulu Park Place was built our building was considered one of the premier condominiums in all of Honolulu. Yet now, like many other older condominiums, HPP has an aging physical plant that is prone to equipment failure and uses far more energy to run than today's technology requires.

The HPP chillers, which provide air conditioning, are our largest single source of energy consumption. These chillers run at a constant



speed no matter what the temperature is outside. It is possible to dramatically reduce that rate by installing a new variable flow chilled water system with direct digital controls. This will result in a significant reduction in energy use and most importantly will generate continued cost savings for HPP.

An LED lighting

upgrade will also contribute to HPP's energy efficient future. Replacing the building's inefficient incandescent and fluorescent lighting with LED technology will reduce energy.

Since a major system replacement is a significant expense, the HPP Board is diligently working on this project to find the best solution for our needs.
