Holiday Recipe for Candied Pecans

- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 tsp ground cinnamon
- 1 tsp salt
- 1 egg white
- 1 tbps water
- 1 pound pecan halves



Preheat oven to 250° F. Mix sugar, cinnamon and salt together in a bowl. Whisk egg white and water together in a separate bowl until frothy. Toss pecans in the egg white mixture. Mix sugar mixture into pecan mixture until pecans are evenly coated. Spread coated pecans onto a baking sheet. Bake in the preheated oven, stirring every 15 minutes, until pecans are evenly browned, about 1 hour. *Delicious! Can't eat just one!*
